We felt, and certainly a lot of us felt, that Europe united could do a lot more for developing countries than each nation can do separately, and I think we proved that in many instances. As far as the developing countries are concerned I do honestly think that liaison we have through the Assembly that has been set up between the European Parliament and now nearly eighty countries, African, Caribbean and Pacific is quite a remarkable thing and, you know, I chaired it for quite a time so I was always very impressed with that. Their eyes were turned not on Britain, not on Germany, Italy, France or whatever; they were turned on Europe.
