VISIT TO CHINA

Since I was familiar with all the different Chinas - Taiwan, Hong Kong and Singapore - but had never been to 'Red China', I decided to travel there to form my own impressions of the country, and could see during my visit that the process of change was also under way over there.

INTERNATIONAL TRAGEDIES: RWANDA

I think the European Community really showed itself to be too weak to enter into a military conflict alone.
